Voters requiring assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write may be given assistance by a person of the voter's choice, with certain restrictions.

A voter who is physically unable to attend the polls without assistance of another person, who is at least 60 years of age, or who expects to be absent from the community while the polls are open, is eligible to receive an absent voter ballot. If you wish to apply for an absent voter ballot, contact your local City or Township Clerk, or call the Michigan Relay Center TDD # 1-800-649-3777.

Your local City or Township Clerk's office will be open until 2:00 p.m. the Saturday immediately preceding the election for the purpose of absent voter ballots.
