It is recommended that drinking water wells be tested at least once a year for bacteria and nitrates, both of which can have adverse health effects. The Ottawa Conservation District is offering a free screening of drinking water samples for nitrates on **June 22, 2018 from 10 AM to 2 PM**, at the Polkton Township Hall. The screening is sponsored by the Michigan Agriculture Environmental Assurance Program (MAEAP) and is open to everyone who uses a personal well for drinking water.
