

JAMESTOWN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 109

An Ordinance to adopt by reference the National Electric Code, 1975 Edition, and to provide for certain supplementations thereto in its application to the Township of Jamestown.

THE TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Name. This Ordinance shall be known as the Jamestown Township Electrical Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Code Adopted. Pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the State of Michigan permitting same, the Township of Jamestown hereby adopts the National Electric Code, 1975 Edition, without amendment but supplemented as set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Schedule of Fees. The following is a schedule of fees which shall be charged at the time the permit is granted:

SECTION 4. Electrical Permits. It shall be lawful for any person, firm, or corporation to begin electrical wiring of any building or other structure before first having obtained an electrical permit therefor.

SECTION 5. Violations. Any firm, person or corporation violating the provisions of the National Electrical Code, 1975 Edition, or the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, (\$100.00) or by imprisonment, for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court. Any wiring done in violation of said Code is hereby declared to be a nuisance per se. Upon application to any Court of competent jurisdiction, the Court may order the nuisance abated and/or the violation, or threatened violation, restrained and enjoined.

SECTION 6. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All former Ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Validity Clause. Should any section, paragraph, sentence or words of this Ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted be held for any reason to be invalid, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any remaining portions of such section or of this Ordinance, it being the intent that this Ordinance and this Code shall stand.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance and Code hereby adopted shall be effective as of the 3rd day of November, 1977.
