

TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN
COUNTY OF OTTAWA, MICHIGAN
ORDINANCE NO. 113

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under the provisions of the Michigan Mechanical Code.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 9 of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972 (Compiled Laws of 1948, Sec. 125.1509), the Township of Jamestown hereby assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the BOCA Basic Mechanical Code , 1978 Edition, as amended) throughout its corporate limits.

The enforcement provisions of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, are hereby adopted by the Township of Jamestown.

Section 2. The Building Inspector for the Township of Jamestown is designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under this Ordinance and the BOCA Mechanical Code.

Section 3. The fees for mechanical inspection shall be those established from time to time by resolution of the Jamestown Township Board.

Section 4. All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance or the BOCA Mechanical Code are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Should any section, paragraph, sentence or words of this Ordinance be held for any reason to be invalid, such holdings shall not be construed as effecting the validity of the remaining portions of such section or of this Ordinance, it being the intent that this Ordinance shall stand.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication thereof.
