

TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN

ORDINANCE NO. 114

An Ordinance to re-adopt by reference updated editions of various construction codes previously adopted by the Township of Jamestown in compliance with Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, and to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the various codes adopted.

THE TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, the BOCA Basic Building Code, 1978 edition together with the One and Two Family Dwelling Code, 1979 amended edition, are hereby adopted by reference, and the Township of Jamestown hereby assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Code, as amended, throughout its corporate limits.

The Building Inspector for the Township of Jamestown is designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under this Ordinance and the Code adopted herein.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Township of Jamestown adopts by reference the National Electrical Code, 1978 edition, throughout its corporate limits except as amended herein and assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Code.

SECTION 210-8 (a) (1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) all 120-volt single phase, 15 and 20 ampere receptacles installed in bathrooms of dwelling units shall have ground fault circuit interrupter protection for personnel."

The Building Inspector for the Township of Jamestown is designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township under this Ordinance and the National Electrical Code, 1978 edition, as amended.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to the provisions of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Township of Jamestown adopts by reference the Michigan Plumbing Code, 1978 edition, and hereby assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the Michigan Plumbing Code, 1978 edition, as amended throughout its corporate limit.

Ottawa County Drain Commission, BCA Engineering, Inc., Grand Haven, is hereby designated the Jamestown Township Plumbing Official pursuant to the Plumbing Inspector Agreement signed between the Township of Jamestown and Ottawa County Drain Commission.

SECTION 4. The fees for inspections under the various Codes adopted above shall be determined from time to time by the Jamestown Township Board by resolution or ordinance as required by state law.

SECTION 5. All former Ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Should any section, paragraph, sentence or words of this Ordinance be held for any reason to be invalid, such holdings shall not be construed as effecting the validity of the remaining portions of such section or of this Ordinance, it being the intent that this Ordinance shall stand.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take affect upon publication thereof.
