RESOLUTION NO. R17-009

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Jamestown Charter Township, Michigan has experienced risks that may damage commercial, residential and public properties, displace citizens and businesses, close streets and impair infrastructure, and present general public health and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, Ottawa County has prepared a *Hazard Mitigation Plan* that outlines the community's options to reduce damages and impacts from natural and technological hazards; and

WHEREAS, the *Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been reviewed by community residents, business owners, and federal, state, and local agencies, and has been revised where appropriate to reflect their concerns;

WHEREAS, the Township deems it advisable to establish, by resolution, such surcharge rates for discharges to the Sewage Works that exceed the City's established limitations, prohibitions or requirements, effective as of July 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The 2017 *Hazard Mitigation Plan Kent and Ottawa Counties* is hereby adopted as an official plan of Jamestown Charter Township


