



Recreational Marijuana will be on the November Ballot.

• NEW LAW WILL NOT REGULATE THE POTENCY OF MARIJUANA.

TODAYS MARIJUANA IS VERY POTENT.

• WILL ALLOW THE TRANSFER OR GIVING OF 2.5 OUNCES OF MJ TO ANOTHER PERSON WITHOUT ANY REGULATION.

• MJ POTENCY HAS INCRESED 36 TIMES SINCE THE 70'S.

• 3 TO 7.5 TIMES MORE THC WHICH IS THE ADDICTIVE COMPOUND IN MARIJUANA, THEN THE MJ OF THE 1980's.

•ALLOWS THE HIGHEST PER PERSON POSSESSION LIMIT OF ANY STATE IN THE NATION.

• ADULTS 10 OUNCES OR APPOXIMATELY 600-880 JOINTS AT HOME.

•2.5 OUNCES PERSONAL POSSESSION IN PUBLIC.

- THE THC LEVEL IN HIGHLY POTENT MJ EDIBLES, 80% TO 90% THC, IS NOT REGULATED.
- ONE GUMMY BEAR EQUALS 10 UNITS OF MARIJUANA.



Let's do some math.


1 gummy = 15 mg THC

Serving suggestion = 10 mg THC

How much would one serving be?

10 mg THC = 2/3 of a gummy worm 15 mg THC

Who on earth eats two-thirds of a gummy worm?



TRAFFIC CRASHES

- MJ impaired driving fatalities have surged in states with recreational MJ.
- Since legalization in Colorado there has been a 66% increase in MJ related traffic deaths.
- Washington State experienced a doubling in drugged driving fatalities in the years following legalization.
- Legalized recreational MJ makes it difficult for police to prove a driver is under the influence of MJ affecting enforcement, accident liability and insurance rates.

CAR INSURANCE

- STATES THAT LEGALIZED RECREATIONAL MJ SAW AN INCREASE OF 16% IN AVERAGE AUTO INSURANCE PREMIUMS THE YEAR AFTER THE LAWS WERE PASSED, AS COMPARED TO THE YEAR PRIOR.
- MICHIGAN AUTO RATES ARE SOME OF THE HIGHEST IN THE NATION.
- THE AVERAGE AUTO PREMIUM IN MICHIGAN IS \$2,600.
- COLORADO SAW A 33% AND NEVADA SAW A 40% INCREASE IN AVERAGE YEARLY PREMIUMS WITHIN THE YEAR PRIOR AND YEAR AFTER LEGALIZATION PASSED.

Truth: Legalizing marijuana will NOT bring in money.

The myth is that legalizing marijuana will create an economic stimulus. Jobs are created and tax revenue is collected; we won't deny that. But, the money being generated doesn't outweigh the public cost.

Let's consider some of the potential "other" costs associated with legalizing marijuana:

- 1. Increased medical costs such as ER visits
- 2. Increased car crashes
- 3. The cost associated with treating addiction
- 4. Loss of productivity at work
- 5. Unintentional exposure to children





Effects of Marijuana Use



MARIJUANA USE & EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES

Studies show that marijuana interferes with attention, motivation, memory, and learning. Students who use marijuana regularly tend to get lower grades and are more likely to drop out of high school than those who don't use. Those who use it regularly may be functioning at a reduced intellectual level most or all of the time.









