ORDINANCE NO. 19-002

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 13-003, AS AMENDED, REGULATING THE IGNITION, DISCHARGE AND USE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS IN THE TOWNSHIP

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN ORDAINS:

Section 1. **Amendment of Section 1.G. of Ordinance No. 13-003.** Section 1.G. of Ordinance No. 13-003, as amended, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

G. National Holiday. Includes any of the following:

1. New Years’ beginning on December 31 at 11:00 a.m. through 1:00 a.m. on January 1st.
2. the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day, beginning at 11:00 a.m. until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
3. June 29 to July 4th beginning at 11:00 a.m. until 11:45p.m. on each of those days.
4. July 5, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, from 11:00 a.m. until 11:45 p.m.
5. the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day, from 11:00 a.m. until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.

Section 2. **Amendment of Section 2.A. of Ordinance No. 13-003.** Section 2.A. of Ordinance No. 13-003, as amended, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

A. Recognized National Holiday. Except as otherwise provided in Section 2.B. of this Ordinance, no person shall ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks within the Township, or allow the ignition, discharge, or use of consumer fireworks within the Township, except on a National Holiday.

Section 3. **Amendment of Section 3.A. of Ordinance No. 13-003.** Section 3.A. of Ordinance No. 13-003, as amended, is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

A. Any person who violates any term or provision of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction and subject to payment of a civil fine in the amount of \$1,000.00 for each violation. Of the \$1,000.00 civil fine collected, \$500.00 shall be remitted to the local law enforcement agency responsible for enforcement of the Ordinance.

Section 4. **Severability and Captions.** This Ordinance and its various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases, and clauses are severable. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, phrase, or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected. The captions included at the beginning of each Section are for convenience only and shall not be considered as part of this Ordinance.

Section 5. **Repeal.** All ordinances which are in conflict in whole or in part with any of the provisions of this Ordinance as of the date of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of that conflict.

Section 6. **Publication/Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective seven days after the publication of a summary of its provisions in a local newspaper of general circulation.
