

TOWNSHIP OF JAMESTOWN
ORDINANCE NO. 115

FARM LAND USE PERMIT ORDINANCE

PURPOSE: The Jamestown Township Board having adopted the BOCA Code and desirous of permitting farmers to continue to obtain a farm use permit as defined under the State Building Code, hereby adopt a resolution to pass a Farm Land Use Permit Ordinance and provide the fees for issuance of said permit as well as to provide penalties for violation for failure to obtain such a permit.

The Jamestown Township Board establishes that the fee be set at \$10.00. Were construction to commence prior to issuance of said permit the fee would be \$20.00.

Were a farmer to refuse to obtain this permit, for any reason, the fee would become \$100.00 and the Township Board would as of each December 1, instruct the assessor to place the \$100.00 fee as a special assessment under "law" on the tax roll for that property involved for that year.

This ordinance to take effect 30 days following approval by the Board and publication thereof.
