Brian Boss, along with Mark Nettleton, shared that options continue to be investigated (legal, economic and practical) so that the Township Board can make an informed decision on the Riley Ridge water pressure issue. This continues to be a work in progress.

Item(s) for Information: Multiple design firms will be interviewed by the Park Planning Committee in upcoming meetings. We are not at a place yet for placing property lines for church properties. The first step is to determine where holding ponds will be located.

A site walk is scheduled for the Mountain Bike Park to proceed. If all looks good, the project will be turned over to the Parks and Recreation Committee.
