Moved by Miller, seconded by Tacoma, to approve Resolution R23-016 to approve and authorize execution of a lease agreement with the Rush Creek Intra-County Chapter XX Drainage District (MEMBA BIKE PARK – PHASE 1). Carried by voice vote.

MEMBA is finalizing agreements and plans for the first segment of the mountain bike trail in Jamestown/Hudsonville. Currently, MEMBA is in the process of scheduling a trail builder and is hopeful that work can be done next summer.
