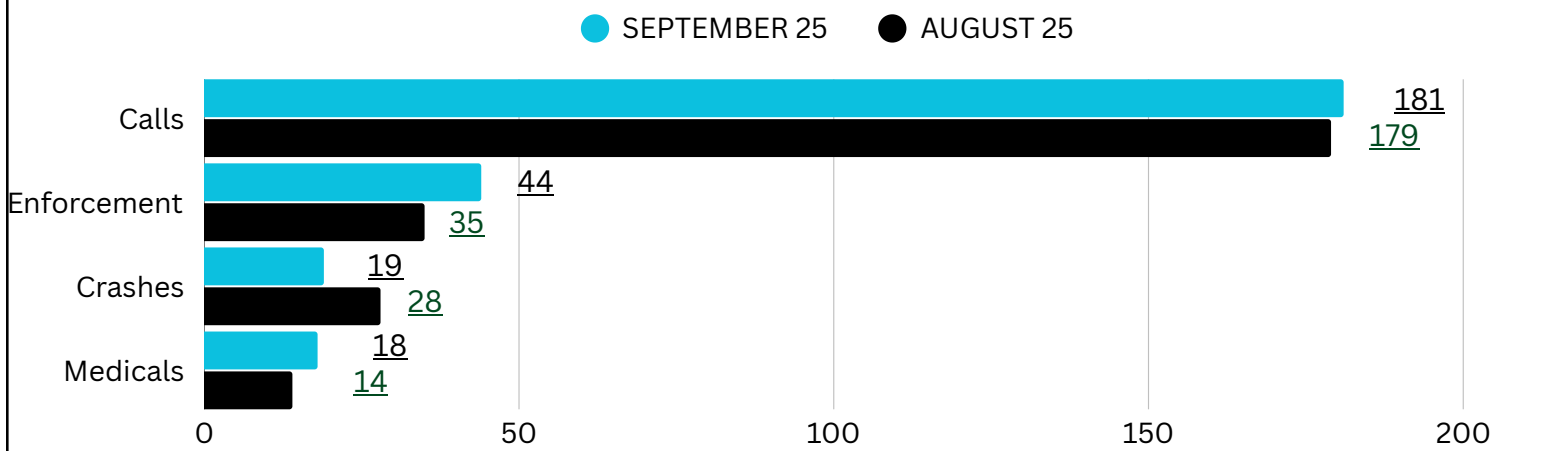

Data Trends



DATA TRENDS:

- Total calls for service for the month of September were at 181, remaining steady in comparison from last month at 179 calls. ↑
- Total Enforcement Activity issued for the month is up 25.71% Deputies issued a total of 44 citations and warnings in September, a 25.71% increase from 35 in August. ↑
- Total Traffic Crashes were down 32.14% Deputies responded to a total of 19 traffic crashes, a decrease from 28 in August. ↓
- Total Medical calls were up 28.57% Deputies responded to a total of 18 medical calls, an increase from 14 in August. ↑

JAMESTOWN TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS:

The Ottawa County Sheriff's Office and the Jamestown Township Fire Department, together with the Marine Corps of America and our local Grand Rapids Harley Davidson Chapter, had the privilege of supporting the Toys for Tots mission.
