Supervisor VanHaitsma called the meeting to order at 7:00pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and opening prayer by Trustee Wolfert.

Moved by DeHaan, seconded by Wolfert, to approve the agenda with postponement of 2025-2026 Audit results until next month. Carried by voice vote.

Moved by Brouwer, seconded by Wolfert, to approve the Township Board Minutes of June 22, 2026. Carried by voice vote.

Reports: Reports were shared by Fire Chief Miedema, Sheriff's Deputy Mingerink and Water/Sewer Administrator Brian Boss.

Chief Miedema shared that the furnace and A/C at Station #2 need replacement. Kurt VanKoevering with the Ottawa County Road Commission was present to answer questions on Proposed Road Improvements.

Moved by DeHaan, seconded by Tacoma, to approve Ordinance #26-007 amending the JCT Zoning Ordinance by adding Section 17.1N – Expiration. Roll call vote: Yeas: Miller, Wolfert, DeHaan, VanHaitsma, Brouwer and Tacoma. Nay: Windemuller. The motion was approved and the ordinance was adopted.

Moved by DeHaan, seconded by Wolfert, to approve an event called Movie Night in the Park on Saturday, August 29. Jamestown Community Park hours will be adjusted on August 29th to accommodate the event. Carried by voice vote.
